- Any individual or business capable of pursuing an investment.
- Anyone with a minimum 12 months of experience in the proposed project.

LOAN FEATURES

- Minimum loan amount of \$200.
- Contribution: 20%
- Interest rate: 9.5%
- Minimum term: 2 years
- Maximum term: 8 years
- Application fees: Loans up to \$9,999 - \$30,000; loans over \$10,000 - \$50,000; loan increase - \$30.00
- Security margins: up to \$10,000: 150%, \$10,001 - \$20,000: 120%, \$20,001 above: 100%
- Grace period: minimum - 6 months; maximum - 8 months
